**Regular Waste and Recycling Service:**

- Place your bins out the night before your collection day
- Lids must open towards the road
- Bins must be placed 50cm apart
- Christmas day is the only public holiday that will affect your collection – Check the Shire or Avon Waste websites

**Green Waste:**

- If you cannot reuse your green waste take it to the Green Waste Only Collection at the top of Camm St.

**Bulk Waste:**

- Can be taken to the Shire Waste Transfer Station on the Brookton-Corrigin Road
- Please separate waste for recycle from waste for disposal
- Please follow directions from the facility operator
- Disposal fees may apply - Call the Shire 9063 2203

**Glass Recycling:**

- Separate your glass at home if you have a separate tub and empty it at the Shire Transfer Station or nearest glass bin
- Check the Shire website for glass drop-off locations

## WHAT TO PUT IN YOUR RECYCLING

- **Cardboard** – clean, flattened boxes and cartons
- **Paper** – clean, untied newspaper, magazines, paper, envelopes, telephone books
- **Plastic** – clean and empty bottles and containers marked with 1, 2 or 3
- **Glass** – clean and empty bottles and jars (No lids)
- **Aluminium** – clean cans, tins and foil
- **Steel** – clean cans, tins and aerosol cans
- **Liquid paperboard** – clean milk, juice and laundry detergent cartons



## WHAT NOT TO PUT IN YOUR RECYCLING

- **Greenwaste** – grass clippings, garden cuttings, leaves and soil
- **Food Scraps**
- **Styrofoam and polystyrene**
- **Electrical goods** – computers, mobiles, e-waste etc
- **Nappies**
- **Steel products** – except steel cans
- **Plastic Bags**



## WHAT NOT TO PUT IN YOUR RUBBISH BIN

- Hot or burning ashes
- Bricks, rocks or soil
- Paints or solvents
- Hazardous material, asbestos or chemicals
- Liquid waste



## WASTE TRANSFER STATION

Brookton-Corrigin Road **OPENING HOURS**

Closed: Good Friday, ANZAC Day, Christmas Day, New Years Day 2018

**Please separate your waste appropriately for disposal and recycling. Talk to the facility operator about what you are disposing of and follow his directions.**

### Transfer Station facilities include:

- Domestic waste bulk bins
- Scrap metal area
- Cardboard only cages
- Used engine oil vessel
- Glass only containers
- Timber products area
- Car batteries collection
- Paint (dried) disposal
- Recycle bins – see recycling guide opposite
- Building & asbestos-free demolition waste

### Fees apply for disposal of:

- Septic and liquid waste - is accepted only from DER licenced contractors with tracking forms
- Asbestos waste - must be delivered double wrapped in heavy duty plastic and labelled ASBESTOS
- Loads in excess of 1 tonne

### CORRIGIN APEX CLUB

#### drumMUSTER

drumMUSTER is the national program that has been set up for the collection and recycling of cleaned, eligible, non-returnable crop production and on-farm animal health chemical containers. Apex runs the program in Corrigin. The collection is run twice a year, usually in March/April and October down at the Shire Works Depot on Walton Street. The musters are advertised in The Windmill and drum delivery bookings are taken at the Shire office.

**Remember to partake in the drumMUSTER your drums must be triple rinsed and dry before delivery!**

APEX recycle aluminium cans in Corrigin. Can cages are placed around town for use by the public or businesses – keep an eye out for them!

#### CORRIGIN ROTARY CLUB
