2018-2019 REGIONAL EVENTS SCHEME

The Regional Events Scheme (RES) is an annual funding round administered by Tourism WA and is supported by Royalties for Regions. The scheme is designed to assist with the development of events as tourist attractions within regional WA.

Who can apply? These grants are available to local government, an incorporated body, a proprietary limited company (Pty Ltd) or an individual person (e.g. John Smith).

How much can I apply for? Event holders can request funding between \$5,000 and \$50,000.

When to apply? The annual funding round is now open for events that fall between July 1, 2018 and June 30, 2019.

The closing **deadline for applications is 5pm WST on Tuesday, December 12, 2017.**

FARM WATER SUPPLY PLANNING SCHEME (TOGETHER WITH FARM WATER REBATE SCHEME)

Who can apply? If you are a commercial broadacre farmer who is experiencing water shortages, you can apply for rebates to fund an audit and site inspection of your farm water supply and improvements, under the Farm Water Supply Planning Scheme. Commercial farmers who have had their farm water supply audited can then apply for a rebate once water supply improvements have been made (under the Farm Water Rebate Scheme).

How much can I apply for? Broadacre farmers can receive subsidies of up to \$500 towards a farm water audit and \$250 for an auditor to complete a call-back inspection. Farmers can claim up to 50 per cent of expenditure on approved water supply works, up to \$15 000 per farming business, every 10 years. All works being claimed must be installed within 18 months of the audit being completed.
