MAY COUNCIL DECISIONS



COUNCIL RENEWAL OF LEASE – TELECOMMUNICATIONS TOWER – 625 CAMM STREET, CORRIGIN

The Shire is renewing two long standing leases for the land where the mobile phone towers are located. These towers, owned and maintained by Optus and Telstra, provide mobile and internet services for the Corrigin community. The new lease terms are for 20 years.

FINANCE POLICY REVIEWS

Council has reviewed and updated two key financial policies to ensure they reflect current accounting standards and audit recommendations. The changes include refining the Significant Accounting Policies and separating out depreciation details into a dedicated policy.

COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM 2025/2026

Council has agreed to consider funding for six local projects and events through the 2025/2026 Community Assistance Program, subject to endorsement in the budget. Applications were received from St John Ambulance, Corrigin Historical Society, Bulyee Hall Committee, Corrigin Golf Club, Corrigin Speedway, and the Corrigin Agricultural Society.

These include equipment purchases, facility upgrades, and support for community events. An additional application for the Corrigin Triathlon, submitted with the Corrigin P&C, will be considered at the June Council Meeting.

WALGA DRAFT ADVOCACY POSITION – STATE DEVELOPMENT APPLICATIONS AND DECISION MAKING

Council supported WALGA's draft position on improving how major development applications are handled by the State.

While Corrigin doesn't receive many of these types of applications, they can create a lot of extra work for small councils without giving them much say in the final decision.

WALGA is calling for changes to make the process fairer and more transparent, with better support for regional areas.

CEO PERFORMANCE REVIEW COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

Council has completed the annual review of the Chief Executive Officer's performance, in line with the requirements of the Local Government Act 1995 and the CEO's contract of employment. The process was supported by an external consultant and considered performance outcomes against agreed criteria. Council agreed to renew the contract for a further five year term when the current contract expires in March 2026. The Council noted that the performance against the Key Performance Indicators and Key Result Areas was satisfactory and thanked Ms Manton and the staff for their efforts over the past year. New targets for performance were set for the coming year.

PLEASE SLOW DOWN THROUGH ROADWORKS

We remind all drivers to reduce their speed and take extra care when driving through roadwork zones. Always obey posted speed limits and signage to ensure the safety of road workers and fellow motorists.

ROADWORKS UPDATE

Verge clearing has commenced on Corrigin - Quairading Road, and the removal of 12 trees has been completed on Rabbit Proof Fence Road. Maintenance grading is ongoing on Bullaring Railway Road, Grylls Road, Jubuk South Road, North Jubuk Road, Jubuk Back Road, and Rafferty Road. Additionally, the Jet Patching truck has been patching potholes and edges on Corrigin South Road and Corrigin Wickepin Road.

TOWN CREW UPDATE

Contractors have been engaged to overseed ryegrass throughout sections on the hockey and football field, to ensure the oval remains green throughout winter. Line marking of both fields are ongoing. The wooden play equipment at Adventure Playground and Rotary Park is being oiled. Additionally, the town crew has been trimming street trees, mowing the ovals and parks, and collecting branches and leaves around town.

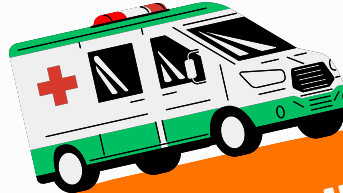

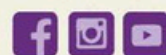
