CEO's Corner

This month we ticked a few long standing projects off our list and started some exciting new projects.

CREC Roof

After six long years of negotiation and legal wrangling the Corrigin Recreation and Events Centre is finally fixed!! The roof leaks and internal damage has been fixed and we can finally put an end to the matter and enjoy the building.

The settlement of former Jehovah's Witness Hall at 17 Hill Street was completed last week and work can now get started on setting it up as a community gym. The building has a large space for gym equipment and is already approved as a public building. There is still some work to be done and details to finalise such as membership, access to the building and equipment to purchase. We are working on having the gym set up and ready to go in the new year.

Local Government Professionals Conference

Last week I attended the LG Professional WA conference in Perth. The presentations from a range of different speakers were very interesting. The conference provided an opportunity to network with colleagues, suppliers and agencies.

Industrial Land

After numerous requests the Department Planning, Lands and Heritage (DPLH) has listed Lot 475 Walton Street on the market for sale with Elders and Commercial Real Estate websites. It is hoped that this block will appeal to anyone wanting to set up a business in Corrigin.

The Shire has also requested that DPLH consider selling 5 and 7 Caley Way and Lot 182 Woglin Road. These lots are being considered for inclusion in the Noongar Land Estate so are not available for now.

Electric Vehicle Chargers

Council is considering applying for funding to install an electric vehicle charger in the main street of Corrigin. Plans have not been finalised but please let us know if you think this is something that would benefit our local community and businesses.

Out on the Roads

Well done to the outside team for finishing the reconstruction and sealing of the Corrigin Quairading Road. The team moved over to re-sheet Doyle Road while they wait for the bitumen contractor to be available for Rabbit Proof Fence Road.



Maintenance grading this month has been done on Whittington Road, Corrigin South Road, Middleton Road, and Doyle Road.



The new prime mover and multi tyre roller arrived this month and have been put to good use on the roads.

Tourism

Cr Jacobs, Tayla Bryant and I attended the Roe Tourism meeting in Beverley this week. Roe Tourism brings together the Shires of Beverley, Bruce Rock, Corrigin, Kondinin, Kulin Lake Grace and Quairading to promote the region and the Pathways to Wave Rock. It was great to hear what other towns in the region have been doing and new projects planned for the future.

The RV area continues to be well used and visitors have made many positive comments about the excellent businesses, facilities, and services in Corrigin. Tourists staying at Gorge Rock will appreciate the new eco toilet and the Corrigin Caravan Park is now much safer following the upgrade of the electrical box.

Town is looking great thanks to the parks and gardens team. The main oval is looking the best I have seen it for years and the other parks and ovals are also looking amazing.

LONG TERM FINANCIAL PLAN 2022-2037 REVIEW

Council have endorsed a desktop review of the long term financial plan to ensure the Shire is on track with current budgeting.

NOTICE OF INTENT TO DRAIN LOTS: 11991, 11993, 10141 & 16003

Council have endorsed a request for drains to be created within various farmland lots, so long as impact to any native bushland surrounding the area is taken into consideration

DISPOSAL OF ASSETS

The Shire is going to dispose of a 2005 Mitsubishi Water truck and a 1982 Pannell Vibrating roller which was not originally included in the budget. The shire is going to retain a 2011 Iveco prime mover for use on the road construction program, which was originally going to be disposed of in the budget.
