DECEMBER 2023 COUNCIL DECISIONS

ANNUAL REPORT AND FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR YEAR ENDING 30 JUNE 2023

The Annual Report and Audited Financial Statements; Auditors Reports and Management Report for the 2022/2023 financial year were accepted by council. The Annual Electors Meeting is to be held at 6pm on Tuesday 6 February 2024 in the Council Chambers.

CHANGE OF PURPOSE – BENDERING TIP RESERVE

In accordance with section 6.11(2) of the *Local Government Act 1995* Council authorised the CEO to give public notice on the intent to change the purpose of the Bendering Tip Reserve Fund from 20 December 2023 until 9 February 2024 advertising the purpose be changed to 'To be used for the continual upgrade, expansion, and rehabilitation of the Bendering Tip Site'.

YOUTH ACTION PLAN

Council endorsed the Shire of Corrigin Youth Action Plan 2023 – 2026 and is available to view on the Shire website.

CORRIGIN WASTEWATER REUSE SCHEME RECYCLED WATER SUPPLY AGREEMENT

Council renewed an agreement with the Water Corporation for the use of recycled water.

POLICY 2.14 SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The updated Significant Accounting Policy was adopted as required by the *Local Government Act 1995*.

Property (Seizure and Sale) Order (PSSO)

In accordance with section 6.64(1)(b) of the *Local Government Act 1995* Council authorised the recovery of rate arrears in excess of 3 years for properties in Corrigin on Newman Street and Hill Street and Forrest Street in Bullaring.

Member number makes returning your 10¢ containers and receiving your refund easy.

FOUR EASY STEPS

- 1) Sign up** - Signing up for a member number takes 30 seconds - all you need is your contact and payment details.
- 2) Save your member number** - Once you're logged in, click Member number in the menu and your unique ID will appear. Download it to your phone's digital wallet (or note it down) so you have it handy during your next return.
- 3) Set your payment method** - Set or update your preferred payment method by clicking Account before choosing Payment method. On mobile, you can find Account by clicking the green figure in the top right corner.
- 4) Start saving containers** - During your next return, show your member number, or if you're doing Drop & Go (Bag Drop), write your member number on a tag. We'll count your 10¢ containers, record it on your account, and process your refund using your preferred payment method.

CORRIGIN TOWNSITE MITIGATION WORKS

Please be aware that there will be mitigation works at the Corrigin Townsite and surrounding areas over the months of February, March and April 2024, depending on weather conditions.

Fire breaks will be made through the reserve to the west of town to allow fire fighters better access in the event of a fire. Forestry mulching will be conducted in areas containing high fuel load.

Corrigin VFRS as well as Corrigin BFB's will conduct controlled burns within the townsite to protect our community from any potential fires when weather conditions are suitable.

The community will be advised of the dates of the controlled burns closer to March.
