CEO's Corner

Here in Corrigin we have enjoyed a certain amount of freedom from the disastrous COVID 19 situation in the eastern states and around the world.

We are very fortunate in Corrigin to have access to the vaccinations and it is pleasing to see that we have a first dose vaccination rate of about 90% and second dose of 85%. This gives us confidence that we may be able to reduce the severity of infections and pressure on our health care services.

The state government continues to issue vaccine mandates for various sectors of the community and we continue to monitor for updates.

Bush Fire Volunteers

Our bush fire volunteers were called to a couple of incidents in the shire this harvest as well as helping our neighbours in the shires of Bruce Rock, Quairading and Wickiepin. The response from volunteers was excellent and they did an amazing job of putting out the fires so quickly. The communications has really improved with the use of What's App groups and I encourage brigade members to join up with their local group.

Thank you to the volunteers who have sent in their COVID vaccination certificates and a reminder to those who have yet to do it to send them in as soon as possible to comply with the mandatory government directions.

Annual Report

Council adopted the 2020/21 Annual Report at the December 2021 meeting. The financial report takes many months to prepare and is a detailed analysis of the shire's financial position at the end of the financial year.

Well done to the finance and administration team for finalising the Annual Report in time for it to be endorsed by the Council at the December Council Meeting. It takes a huge amount of work to bring the Annual Report together. The report is available on the Shire of Corrigin website and an overview will be provided at the Annual Electors Meeting on Monday 7 February 2022.

Council Meetings

The Council meeting dates are available on the shire website and members of the public are very welcome to attend. Council meetings are generally held on the third Tuesday of the month at 3pm and there is provision at the beginning of every meeting for public questions and also for deputations or presentations.

Christmas Lights

The Councillors and seniors enjoyed a trip around town on 21 December 2021 to judge the Christmas lights competition. Congratulations to everyone who put up Christmas lights and made the town look amazing.

Out on the Roads

Spare a thought for our Shire of Corrigin outside crew and contractors who are working out in the heat to finish the road construction program.

The works crew finished the Quairading Corrigin Road before taking a well earned break over the Christmas and

New Year period. Thank you for your patience in negotiating the road works during the busy harvest period.

The crew have now moved back to the Rabbit Proof Fence Road and are continuing with general road maintenance.

Contractors for Main Roads started work on improvements to the Brookton Highway and Rabbit Proof Fence Road intersection during January. This project has been in the planning stages for several years and will hopefully make this dangerous intersection much safer in future.

Behind the Scenes

Over the past few months I have been working on a couple of issues and advocating on behalf of the Corrigin community including the Local Government Act reform, housing availability and increasing the amount of industrial land.

I also attended a meeting to progress health services advocacy and actions on the priorities of:

- GP and health workforce attraction and retention
- Guaranteed availability of services and transportation
- Aged care services, packages, and policy
- Volunteer workforce e.g., St John's Ambulance.

DECEMBER 2021 COUNCIL DECISIONS

Long Term Financial Plan 2021 - 2031 Review

Council adopted the reviewed version of the Shire of Corrigin Long Term Financial Plan. This plan informs the Corporate Business Plan to activate Strategic Community Plan priorities. From these plans annual budgets that are aligned with strategic objectives can be developed.

Annual Report and Financial Statements

Council accepted the Annual Report and Audited Financial Statement, auditors report and management report for the 20/21 financial year and agreed to hold the Electors Meeting on Monday 7 February 2022 commencing at 6.30pm at the CRC.

Local Government Proposed Reforms 2021

Council endorsed the Shire of Corrigin feedback and comments in response to the Local Government Reform Proposals consultation paper. These include earlier intervention, effective regulation and stronger penalties; reducing red tape, increasing consistency and simplicity; greater transparency and accountability; stronger local democracy and community engagement; clear roles and responsibilities; improved financial management and reporting.

Ordinary Council Meeting Dates 2022

Council approved the meeting schedule for Ordinary Council Meetings for 2022, commencing at 3pm in the Shire of Corrigin Council Chambers.

Bendering Waste Site Lease Agreement

Council agreed to enter into a lease of the Bendering Waste Site with Notting Nominees Pty Ltd for a period of five years with a five-year option for nil cost.

CORRIGIN WELLNESS CENTRE



Stevenson Scholarship for Further Education

APPLICATIONS NOW OPEN

The Stevenson Scholarship was established by the late Edna Stevenson (a former resident of the Shire of Corrigin) to promote and advance the education of the residents of the Shire of Corrigin. Stevenson Scholarships are administered by the Trustees of the Edna Stevenson Trust.

Eligibility

Stevenson Scholarships are available to students who are residents of the Shire of Corrigin and/or whose parents or guardians are not able to provide sufficient financial assistance for the student to achieve a tertiary education.

Resident Status

Residents are defined as:

- A person residing in the Shire of Corrigin at the time of applying for the Stevenson Scholarship.
- A former resident of the Shire of Corrigin (of not more than two years absence) who was a student at a school in the Shire

of Corrigin for at least three years whose immediate family resides in Corrigin.

Student Status

Students must be enrolled in and attending any of the following:

- Corrigin District High School
- Any government run senior high school in Western Australia
- An agricultural high school or college in Western Australia
- A TAFE college in Western Australia
- A university in Western Australia

Scholarships

Scholarships provide financial assistance to help cover the costs of text books, enrolment fees and course fees at approved educational institutions.

The following amounts are indicative only, lesser or greater amounts may be awarded depending on the course of study and financial need:

- **SECONDARY STUDY up to \$2,000**

- **TERTIARY STUDY up to \$5,000**

Scholarships are awarded for one year periods. Scholarship recipients may apply for further scholarships on a year by year basis.

The WA Chief Health Officer has issued Fire and Emergency Services Worker (Restrictions on Access) Directions (2) under the Public Health Act 2016 requiring all fire and emergency services workers, including bush fire brigade volunteers, to be vaccinated against COVID-19. The directions mean that all volunteers need to have received their first vaccination by 31 December 2021 and second dose by 31 January 2022. Unvaccinated volunteers are only able to attend a fire on their own property or if insufficient vaccinated volunteers are available.

PROOF OF VACCINATION

Bushfire volunteers are required to provide evidence of vaccination status. Failing to provide proof of vaccination, or valid exemption is an offence, punishable by a fine of up to \$20,000. Once you have obtained your certificate or statement, you can provide to DFES or the Shire of Corrigin using the following options:

- **Upload** your certificate on the Volunteer Hub at www.volunteerhub.dfes.wa.gov.au/logon The Hub is a secure site and once complete, your vaccination status will be visible in your personal profile.
- If you do not currently have access to the Volunteer Hub, or have forgotten your password, contact your DFES regional office in Narrogin on 6832 3110.
- **Email DFES** a PDF copy of your certificate to covidcert@dfes.wa.gov.au. To ensure your certificate is processed you must include: Full name, Volunteer ID number, Name of your Brigade
- **In Person.** Take a copy of your certificate to DFES regional office in Narrogin.
- **Email Shire of Corrigin** a PDF copy of your certificate to shire@corrigin.wa.gov.au
