The plan is for contractors to start work after Easter on the repairs to the roof over the hockey and netball changerooms. They will then move on to the main roof section over the function area and football change rooms in mid May.

COUNCIL DECISIONS

COMPLIANCE AUDIT RETURN

Council reviewed the 2022 Compliance Audit Return for the period 1 January 2022 to 31 December 2022 which assists the Shire of Corrigin to monitor legislative compliance under the *Local Government (Audit) Regulations 1996*.

BUSH FIRE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Council is required to establish and maintain a Bush Fire Advisory Committee in accordance with the *Bush Fires Act 1954* to provide adequate fire protection to the Shire. For the Shire to comply with the statutory requirements of the Act, the Bush Fire Advisory Committee recommended for Council adoption the Fire Control Officers and the Fire Break Orders for the 2023/2024 period. For more information on the fire control officers, brigade representatives, harvest ban officers dual fire control officers and the Fire Break Orders can be found on the Shire website.

DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION - PROPOSED WORKFORCE ACCOMMODATION

Council approved the development application submitted by Cooperative Bulk Handling Pty Ltd to erect 6 transportable accommodation dwellings on Lot 21 (70) Corrigin South Road, Corrigin subject to numerous conditions and advice notes.

DICK LAW ROSE BOWL

The Shire of Corrigin hosted teams from Bruce Rock and Narembeen on 24 March 2023 for the Annual Dick Law Rose Bowl event. We were pleased to be able to finally host the event this year after it was deferred last year due to the fire.

The day commenced with a tour of the town. The visiting Councils were very impressed with the presentation of the town and the recently completed projects. The day continued with a light lunch and an afternoon of lawn bowls.
