# CEO's Corner

There is something very satisfying about cleaning up around the house and yard in preparation for the summer fire season. The crisp mornings and warm days are perfect for raking, mowing, mulching, burning and composting.

A reminder that the green waste tip is for branches, leaves, clippings and cuttings only. You can help to reduce the volume of your green waste through composting, mulching or recycling on site. Soil, bricks, building rubble, timber, plastic and pallets are to be taken to the Waste Transfer Station NOT the green waste tip.

There are plenty of gardeners keen for free or cheap supplies of animal manure, old hay or straw, shredded paper or other compostable material so please ask around or try local community pages instead of the green waste tip.

#### Blaze Aid

Thank you to Bronny, Ron and the Blaze Aid volunteers who finished up in Corrigin on 5 May 2023.

The team started on 11 April and cleared 31.4km of burnt fencing and erected 8.7km of new fences across 9 properties.

#### **CREC Roof Update**

The first part of the roof repairs over the change rooms has been completed and workers are expected back on site in mid June 2023 to complete the main roof repairs.

The water damage to light fittings and wiring has caused some failures of circuits lately but is expected to be fixed in the coming month.

#### It is a Busy Time

The Shire team have been busy finishing off many projects as the end of the financial year comes to a close. Almost \$4million of capital works have been completed since July 2022 and there is more to come in 2023-24.

The timeframes for some projects have been extended due to the availability of materials and contractors. Many of our planned vehicle changeovers have been delayed due to extended supply timelines

The large road construction program has been completed and the outside crew have moved on to the maintenance of our road network.

The works team reconstructed approximately 5.55km on Rabbit Proof Fence Road and 2km on the Corrigin Quairading Road as well as widened the shoulders on 3km of the Bilbarin Quairading Road. The Old Kulin Road and Pontifex Road were gravel sheeted and 25km of bitumen roads were resealed.

The inside staff have been finalising accounts for the end of the financial year and working on the budget for 2022/23.

# MAY 2023 COUNCIL DECISIONS

### DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION – PROPOSED NEW STORAGE SHED FOR RURAL PURSUIT/HOBBY FARM PURPOSES

A development application for a storage shed on Woglin Street was granted conditional approval.

#### **CEO PERFORMANCE REVIEW**

CEO performance review for the period March 2022 – February 2023 has been completed and council have approved the CEO's performance criteria for the 2023-2024 period.

#### 2023/2024 COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Council accepted three applications for Community Assistance from the following organisations in Corrigin:

- 1. Corrigin Triathlon Club
- 2. Corrigin Creative Arts Club
- 3. Corrigin Agricultural Society

Council also supported a request from the Corrigin Agricultural Society to increase contribution for the fireworks display and unveiling of the 100 Years of the Corrigin Show Mural at the sundowner on 8 September 2023.

The sponsorship for the Lake Yealering Regatta was also supported. All Community Assistance Applications are subject to budget adoption in July 2023.

### REPORT ON DISPOSAL 2 LINDSAY RISE, GRANITE RISE ESTATE

The council authorised the CEO to finalise the sale of 2 Lindsay Rise (Lot 25), Granite Rise Estate, Corrigin.

#### **ANNUAL ELECTORS MEETING**

The Annual Electors Meeting and presentation of financial statement was held on 16 May following the Council meeting.






