- 160mm mainline poly is cheaper to buy than 150mm RRJ class 12 PVC, its also cheaper to install and it comes in 100m rolls (so less joins = less maintenance) is poly mainline an option as per tender
- Thinkwater Perth specialises in playing field renovations, therefore we normally use a vibrating plough to install the laterals on the ovals. This allows our customers/clients to use the playing fields at the end of the work day. EG we would install ¼ oval during the day and you can hold footy/hockey practice on it in the evening, with NO trenches and need for lawn repair. Is poly laterals an option?
