REGISTER FOR EMAIL OF RATES NOTICES

To register to receive your rates notice via email, please contact the rates officer at shire@corrigin.wa.gov.au.

There can only be ONE email address assigned to the assessment and you must be the owner of the property to register for eRates. Please check your junk email once registered.



CHECK IF YOU'RE ELIGIBLE FOR A RATES REBATE?

If you are the holder of a current and valid card below, you may be eligible for a rates and emergency services levy rebate for your owned and self-occupied property:

Pensioner Concession Card (50% Rebate)
Commonwealth Seniors Health Card and WA Seniors Card
(50% Rebate)

State Concession Card (50% Rebate) WA Seniors Card (25% Rebate)



You may be eligible for a State Government funded Rate Rebate under the provisions of the Rates and Charges (Rebates and Deferments) Act 1992 if you are the owner and occupier of that property on the 1st July each financial year.

Applications for these rebates can be made by phoning the Water Corporation on 1300 659 951 or provide an online application via www.watercorporation.com.au.

The eligibility date will be that of your application lodgement date with the Water Corporation and cannot be back dated.

RESPONSIBLE DOG OWNERSHIP

A brief reminder of some responsibilities of dog ownership in the Shire of Corrigin.

REGISTRATION

All dogs ages over 3 months must be registered and microchipped. Registrations are due 31 October each year. Please notify us of any deaths or transfers out of the Shire before October.



BARKING

A dog that makes continuous noise in a public or private space that interferes with the peace and comfort of any person may be considered a nuisance.

Complaints can be lodged via a form available at the Shire Administration Office and are investigated by the Shire's Ranger Service.

UNLEASHED DOGS

To avoid your dog roaming unaccompanied, resulting in them being impounded, please ensure your pet is contained securely within your property.

Dogs must be on a leash at all times in public areas unless it is a designated dog exercise area.

The two designated areas are Apex Park and east of the lighting towers at the Main Oval at Corrigin Recreation and Events Centre.
