All applications for new or replacement Standpipe Access Cards will incur a \$20 fee. A separate application form is required for each new or replacement card.



CONDITIONS OF ACCESS

The Shire of Corrigin provides standpipes to allow access to scheme water for members of the community who do not have access to readily available water supplies.

Water supplied from standpipes is drinking quality scheme water provided by the Water Corporation and proper thought should be given to its use and storage.

- **Misuse of water taken from standpipes may result in access being withdrawn.**
- The permit holder is responsible for the safety and security of the Standpipe Access Card and all charges that result from the use of the card to obtain water from Shire of Corrigin standpipes.
- Accounts for water charges will be issued on a regular basis and are required to be paid within the Shire's trading terms of 7 days.
- Lost or stolen cards must be reported to the Shire of Corrigin immediately. Cards reported lost or stolen will be cancelled.
- All applications for new, replacement or additional cards will incur a \$20 fee.
- During times of drought or water shortages, access to standpipes may be restricted or prohibited for periods as determined by the Water Corporation or the Shire of Corrigin.
- Any damage to a standpipe or its surrounds or any abuse or unauthorised activity by others must be reported immediately to the Shire of Corrigin.
- Should access to standpipes be abused the Shire of Corrigin reserves the right to withdraw the service.
- Standpipes are located on Connelly Parade, Corrigin and Bullaring Pingelly Road, Bullaring.
